



Manual Storage Capacity





Automation System Details



- Automated racking system (OSR) of 37,000 box locations that operates with 12 high speed lift platforms and 90 automated shuttles
- 5 Goods-to-Person stations with pick-to-light operation for B2B and B2C order picking
- 10 packing stations for B2C orders
- 1,500m conveying system for transporting boxes between OSR, picking, packing & dispatch areas












Automation Goods-IN Area









Picking capacity = 580 pcs/hr/station (2.900 pcs/hr or 40.600 pcs/day in 2 shifts)



Executive Summary



- System Go-Live: end of January 2022
- More than 2.5 mio pieces picked & shipped up to end of June through the new system for store replenishment and e-shop
- Warehouse relocation took place within 3 days and without stopping stores replenishment
- New system productivity is +63% vs. old
- Picking performance: max AVG at Schimatari was 330pcs/hr, and now is 540pcs/hr at Oinofyta
